The Appraiser represents the City of Auburn and must convey a professional image and provide excellent customer service.

The ideal candidate for this position will possess or have the ability to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to complete assessing duties including field inspections, data analysis, data entry, deed research, mapping, and numerous additional appraisal duties.
