





CONSTRUCTION SHALL NOT COMMENCE UNTIL AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY OF AUBURN.

GRANITE CURBING (INCLUDING CATCH BASIN HEADSTONES) SHALL BE INSTALLED IN A CONCRETE BASE.SEE SPECIAL PROVISION 609. PAYMENT FOR CONCRETE WORK SHALL BE UNDER ITEM 609.50.

ALL GRANITE CURBING (INCLUDING CATCH BASIN HEADSTONES) THAT IS REMOVED AND STACKED AND NOT REUSED ON THE PROJECT SHALL BE TURNED OVER TO THE CONTRACTOR.

T IS THE CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITY TO FAMILIARIZE THEMSELVES WITH THE EXISTING CONDITIONS PRIOR TO BIDDING.

CONSTRUCT BUTT JOINTS AT ALL PAVED DRIVES AND ENTRANCES. BUTT JOINTS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM WIDTH OF 18 INCHES OR AS NOTED ON THE PLANS.

GRIND TRANSITION TAPERS AT CATCH BASINS UNDER STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS TEM 202.203, PAVEMENT BUTT JOINTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD DETAIL 09(05), GUTTER GRADE TRANSITION AT CATCH BASIN, OR AS DIRECTED BY THE NSPECTOR.

ANY NECESSARY CLEANING OF EXISTING PAVEMENT PRIOR TO PAVING (OR MILLING) SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE RELATED PAVING (OR MILLING) ITEMS. THIS INCLUDES ILLING AND REMOVAL OF ALL VEGETATIVE MATTER.

PLANS OF PREVIOUSLY CONSTRUCTED PROJECTS ARE AVAILABLE ON REQUEST. THESE PROJECTS ARE:

MOUNT AUBURN AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, 2022.

ALL HMA FOR PATCHING AROUND ADJUSTED, ALTERED, OR REBUILT UTILITY STRUCTURES SHALL BE 12.5 MM MAINEDOT APPROVED MIX DESIGN. EXCLUDING WATER AND GAS GATE VALVES, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SAW CUT THE EXISTING PAVEMENT FOR THE PATCH AT LEAST TWO FEET AWAY FROM THE NEAREST EDGE OF THE STRUCTURE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE HMA IN LIFTS OF 2 INCHES OR LESS TO MATCH THE EXISTING PAVEMENT DEPTH OR A MAXIMUM OF 6 INCHES, AS DIRECTED BY THE NSPECTOR, AND COMPACT THE HMA USING A MINIMUM OF A 150-LB PLATE COMPACTOR. HMA FOR PATCHING AROUND ADJUSTED, ALTERED, OR REBUILT UTILITY STRUCTURES IS CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO THE RESPECTIVE PAY ITEM FOR ADJUST, ALTER, OR REBUILD UTILITY STRUCTURE.


